Academic Measures:

i-Ready—A state-approved diagnostic assessment for scholars in grades K-8 in reading and math. This assessment is taken by all scholars in grades K-8 as a nationally normed reference assessment to have an understanding of how scholars are performing as compared to their peers. The Ohio Department of Education uses this assessment to measure reading readiness and growth amongst students in grades kindergarten through Third. Teachers use this data to plan daily instruction and is used daily by all scholars.

OST — Ohio State Assessments—scholars in grade 3-8 are tested to assess mastery of Ohio's Learning Standards. The results are used to strengthen future instruction.
